## Setting

Act One: Present day New York City building tops. Statue of liberty and other famous landmarks.

Act Two: The Future, New Jersey. A barren wasteland filled with the scum of the earth. (See present day New Jersey)

Act Three: Alternating between Present and Future New York and New Jersey.

Warning/Caution: This production contains graphic violence, nudity, sex and alcohol references, and adult languages (English and Finnish). This show will also contain the use of live firearms, smoke machines, strobe lights, pyrotechnics and will include, but is not limited to, racist, sexist, and Finnish remarks. This production will be as offensive as it is FUCKING AWESOME!

*The audience sits in a theatre with their playbills that contain the above information plus cast names. The tickets were extremely expensive and non-refundable.*

*The house lights dim and the pre-show lights remain on a closed curtain. For 4 solid minutes.*

*A cell phone in the audience rings, the ring tone is an extremely loud ring of "99 bottles of Beer on the Wall". It rings in the silent house until it reaches 89 Bottles of Beer on the Wall before we hear:*

**Man**

(Not making any attempt to be quiet)

Oh that's me! Sorry.

**Man (cont.)**

Hello?

**Man (cont.)**

Oh hey, what's up?

**Man (cont.)**

Oh that's cool, I'm in a watching a play.

**Man (cont.)**

A play? It's like a stage thing.

**Man (cont.)**

Oh no, it hasn't started yet.

**Man (cont.)**

I'm not sure what it's about, I won tickets from a radio station.

**Man (cont.)**

KCAT.

**Man (cont.)**

Ha! Yeah, 102.2 K-CAT MeeeeeeeeeeeeOW! (Chuckles and sighs)

**Man** (cont.)

So, what are you doing after this?

**Man** (cont.)

Lame! Wanna get dinner?

**Man** (cont.)

I dunno, TGI Friday's?

**Man** (cont.)

No, I can't go back to Red Lobster after what their shrimp did to my stomach and what I did to their bathroom.

**Man** (cont.)

What? You didn't hear about that? It was in the newspaper because of the "Hazardous Waste" that was---

*A man with a headset looking like a stage manager comes out on stage*

**Man** (cont.)

Oh! I looks like it's starting. I'll call you back.

**Stage Manager**

Uh, hi. Good evening... Well, uh... It appears that due to technical difficulties and a recent fatality of a cast member that we have to cancel tonight's performance of "Spectacle Extravaganza". Very sorry. Good Night.

*House lights come on.*
